Operational Assistance Scheme for VO's

The Aims of the Scheme shall be to:

- Support VOs whose operation is related and essential for the the COVID -19 pandemic.
 - Support VOs which, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, may suffer irreparable damage to their organisation, including loss of employment, which may result in the reduction of operation in the near future of the same organisation and/or the closure of the same organisation.
 - Support VOs which, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, may face difficulties to retain and restart the operation at post pandemic stage.
- The total amount of funds allocated in the COVID-19 Assistance Scheme for VOs shall be of €3,000,000.00.
